





COURSE PROFILE OVERVIEW 2,5 km



COURSE PREPARATION & GROOMING

Schedule for Grooming

Track is groomed and marked on Sunday morning 8:30.

Competitions will be held on mixed snow. Track is 1,75 km or 2,5 km. Last decision about track will be done latest at 8:00 on Sunday morning. It will be updated on the web page. Track is in good condition and will provide good venue for the competitions.

3 km = 2 laps (or 1x 2,5 km) 5 km = 3 laps (or 2x 2,5 km) 7,5 km = 4 laps (or 3x 2,5 km) 10 km = 6 laps (or 4x 2,5 km) 15 km = 8 laps (or 6x 2,5km)

Classical technique competitions: Two tracks for whole course, turning technique zones will

be seen on a Sunday morning, pole length control is front of stadium office.

Because of corona pandemic, only athletes and necessary personnel are allowed to the competition venue. Spectators are not allowed to the event.

Only athletes during competition and warm-up can be without face mask.

GENERAL INFORMATION FROM THE OC

Arrive to the venue as late as possible and leave as fast as possible after your race. Warm-up after race is better to do elsewhere.

Dressing rooms are not in use and there won't be any indoor facilities available. Restrooms are in the first-floor dressing rooms. Leave indoors as fast as possible.

There won't be warm-up track or ski testing place. Skiing during competitions on race track is not allowed. Warm-up and testing before competitions or in scheduled breaks only for athletes wearing starting bib inside out.

Each athlete collects his or her's bib by themselves. Athelete is responsible to take right bib. If you don't find your bib, call +358 50 5404624.

Only athletes are allowed to enter start and finish area. Area is marked by fences.

Live online-results are official results after 15 min of last finish in each class

Prizes can be collected from the "vending window" on the first floor of the stadium building right in front of the finish. On sunday 16 year old and under also six best and in FIS-classess three best.
